

Budget Workshop Meeting  
November 10, 2021

The Franklin Township Supervisors met on the above date at the Franklin Township Administration Office. Present were Supervisors Jason Frey, Barbara Beltz, and Robin Cressley; and Secretary-Treasurer Brenda Cressley. A list of others in attendance is attached to the Minute Book. The purpose of the meeting was to hold a Budget Workshop Meeting to prepare the year 2021 Township budgets. The meeting was called to order at 6:00 p.m. by Chairman Jason Frey and led those present in the Pledge of Allegiance to the American Flag.

New Business

Franklin Township's Chief of Police Jason Doll was present to discuss his department's budget for 2022. The Board of Supervisors and Chief Doll reviewed line by line the budget figures presented for five full-time police officers. Chief Doll requested a few items to be purchased in the 2022's budget such as a Breathalyzer, Light Rack, Charger for Vascar, and a Bulletproof Vest along with some other minor items.

After the few adjustments made at tonight's workshop meeting the anticipated (estimated) balance forward on December 31, 2022 will be \$366,079.67. The Supervisors were pleased to note through some cutbacks in some departments they will once again not have to increase taxes if the budget is adopted as proposed.

No public comments.

Barbara Beltz made a motion to adjourn at 7:30 p.m. Robin Cressley seconded the motion. Motion carried unanimously.
