

April 5, 2022
Workshop Meeting Minutes

The Franklin Township Supervisors met on the above date at the Franklin Township Administration Building located at 889 Fairyland Road. Township Officials present were Supervisors, Fred Kemmerer, Robin Cressley, and Jason Frey; and Secretary Brenda Cressley. A list of others in attendance at the meeting is attached to the Minute Book. Chairman Kemmerer called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m., and led those present in the Pledge of Allegiance to the American Flag.

Chairman Kemmerer explained the purpose of this workshop meeting was to continue with suggestions on how to use the American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) funds and to begin setting a budget.

Supervisor Frey presented two different samples/quotes of companies that sell Salt Storage Sheds. They are as follows:

Hybrid Building Solutions – their quote is for all materials and installation of the shed
Quoted Price- \$73,068.00 (Township would still have to lay blacktop for the base)

FarmTek- their quote is just for the supplies/materials (only) for the shed.
Quoted Price - \$11,517.00 Township would have to lay blacktop, install and purchase cement blocks)

There was discussion on estimating what it will cost for the Township to install the Salt Shed, ex: wages for installation; where to purchase the cement blocks and how many they would need; Cost of blacktop; plywood; rental of high lift machine. After further discussion they decided the Township would install the Salt Shed and estimated total costs would be around \$35,000.00.

The Franklin Township Fire Police submitted a request for nine (9) new radios- Quote from ECCO Communication Radios- \$4,212.00.

The Franklin Township submitted an additional request for the purchase of supplies needed for the KNOX BOX- \$3,058.00

Supervisor Cressley discussed the purchase of a Flail Mower and a Generator for the Township Garage and Police Building. They discussed instead of purchasing a flail mower they could purchase an attachment for the skid loader to cut the grass along the roadways.

Supervisors also discussed budgeting Signs for Roads (Street Signs, Chevrons, Arrows etc.)

Supervisor Kemmerer suggested purchasing a 4G Camera to be used for Virtue and Zoom Meetings.


