

RESOLUTION NO. 2021 – 13

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF FRANKLIN, COUNTY OF CARBON, COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA, APPOINTING ANY FRANKLIN TOWNSHIP POLICE OFFICER (INCLUDING THE CHIEF OF POLICE) TO ENFORCE FRANKLIN TOWNSHIP ORDINANCE NO. 2021-01 ENTITLED THE “FRANKLIN TOWNSHIP STORMWATER MANAGEMENT ORDINANCE”.

WHEREAS, Franklin Township is a township of the second class located in Carbon County, Pennsylvania; and,

WHEREAS, on or about February 16, 2021, Franklin Township enacted an ordinance entitled the “Franklin Township Stormwater Management Ordinance”; and,

WHEREAS, by Ordinance No. 2021-03, enacted on October 19, 2021, the Board of Supervisors of Franklin Township amended the Franklin Township Stormwater Management Ordinance by adding a new section 807 which provides:

This Ordinance may be enforced by the Franklin Township Supervisors, a Franklin Township Zoning Officer, a Franklin Township Building Code Official, the Franklin Township Engineer, and such other person or persons who may be designated in a resolution duly adopted by the Board of Supervisors of Franklin Township.

WHEREAS, pursuant to section 807, the Board of Supervisors of Franklin Township may designate such other person or persons to enforce the Franklin Township Stormwater Management Ordinance by a resolution duly adopted by the Board of Supervisors of Franklin Township.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED that in addition to the Franklin Township Supervisors, a Franklin Township Zoning Officer, a Franklin Township Building Code Official, and the Franklin Township Engineer, any Franklin Township police officer (including the


Chief of Police) is designated as a person or persons with authority to enforce the Franklin Township Stormwater Management Ordinance.


