The purpose of the meeting was to hold a Budget Workshop Meeting to prepare the year 2024 Township budgets, and other business brought to the board. 
A discussion was held with Interim Road Foreman, Kim Hunsicker regarding the road crew budget. They reviewed each account number pertaining to roads. They also reviewed the garbage and police vehicles budgets as far as tires and maintenance that will be needed in 2024. They reviewed the job/wage scale for the road and garbage crews along with the 2024 tar and chip project, and blacktopping road projects.

The last item discussed was garbage collection and the board tentatively decided they would not have to raise the garbage collection rates.

The Board of Supervisors will meet on Wednesday, November 15, 2023 at 7:00 p.m. to review the final budget figures and make any adjustments they feel is needed to maintain a balanced budget.

There were no public comments.
