

Franklin Township Advisory Recreation and Parks Board  
April 2, 2024

The Franklin Township Advisory Recreation and Parks Board met on the above date at the Franklin Township Administrative Building. Board members present were Fred Kemmerer Jr., Robert Correll, and Brenda Cressley, Secretary. Chairman Kemmerer called the meeting to order at 6:30 p.m. and led the meeting in saying the Pledge of Allegiance.

Brenda Cressley made a motion to reappoint Fred Kemmerer Jr. as Chairman of the Franklin Township Advisory Recreation and Parks Board. Robert Correll seconded the motion. Motion carried unanimously.

Fred Kemmerer Jr. made a motion to reappoint Brenda Cressley as Secretary of the Franklin Township Advisory Recreation and Parks Board. Robert Correll seconded the motion. Motion carried unanimously.

Robert Correll made a motion to approve the minutes from the September 5, 2023. Franklin Township Advisory Recreation and Parks Board Meeting. Fred Kemmerer Jr. seconded the motion. Motion carried unanimously.

Brenda Cressley made a motion to hold the Recreation Board Meetings on the first Tuesday of the month at 6:30 p.m. Dates of meetings are as follows May 7th, June 4th, August 6th, September 3rd, and October 1st. Robert Correll seconded the motion. Motion carried unanimously.

Secretary Reports

Township resident Kim Neifert asked if the post with outlets in the ground located behind her mailbox is live. She would like to replace her mailbox and post but is worried that the outlets are live and if she digs she might hit it. The post is located near the entrance of the Phifer's Ice Dam Park and was used when the Lions' Club did the annual Christmas display. Robert Correll said he is not aware that the outlet would be live.

Mrs. Neifert also stated because the shed at the entrance of Phifer's Ice Dam Park is no longer being used could it be used somewhere else in the park like a garden shed. Robert Correll said he would check with the Lion Members to see what they what to do with it. Fred Kemmerer also said we could put it up back and out of the way for now.

Fred & Robert will meet on Saturday morning 4/6/24 to check on the power of the line coming out of fuse box down near Cindy's Deli.

Brenda gave the board members an update on the Christman Ballfield project, informing them of the grant that was received of \$250,000.00 from DCED.

The Lehighon Men's Softball League signed the Resolution (2022-15) for use of the Bunker Hill Ballfield for the year of 2024.

Fred suggested having a Community Yard Sale and a Car Show and also having a National Night Out held at the Park.

Motion was made by Fred Kemmerer to hold a National Night Out Event on August 6, 2024. He will look into possibly having some food trucks at the event, and Robert will check to see if the Lions' would like to sell food too.

Robert Correll made a motion to adjourn the meeting at 7:10 p.m. Fred Kemmerer seconded the motion. Motion carried unanimously.
