

May 21, 2024

The Franklin Township Supervisors met on the above date at the Franklin Township Administration Building located at 889 Fairyland Road. Township Officials present were Supervisors Fred Kemmerer, Robin Cressley, and Leroy Kemmerer Jr.; and Secretary Brenda Cressley; A list of others in attendance at the meeting is attached to the Minute Book. Chairman Kemmerer called the meeting to order at 6:30 p.m., and led those present in the Pledge of Allegiance to the American Flag.

Robin Cressley made a motion to approve the minutes of the April 16, 2024 Township Meeting. Leroy Kemmerer Jr. seconded the motion. Motion carried unanimously.

Secretary's Report –

The Secretary announced there would be a change for Memorial Day's garbage collection. Monday, May 27th will be picked up on Tuesday, May 28th.

Carbon County Planning & Development Office held a Public Hearing regarding the 2024 CDBG money on Tuesday, April 30, 2024 at 10:00 a.m. Copy of Agenda was sent. Franklin Township will be receiving \$98,514.00. \$17,732.00 for administration and \$80,782.00 for our selected project

Treasurer's Report – Robin Cressley moved to accept the Treasurer's Report. Leroy Kemmerer Jr. seconded the motion. Motion carried unanimously.

Central Carbon Municipal Authority – Fred Kemmerer Jr. submitted the CCMA minutes and reports from the April 15, 2024 meeting. Fred reported that CCMA is cracking down on the I & I issues they are having at the plant, regarding the use of sump pumps. Franklin Township addressed the matter by sending letter to all residents who have central sewer a reminder that sump pumps should not be going into the septic system.

Citizen Participation –

Township Resident Gary Trainer was present to request the township's approval to construct a new entrance sign for the Phifer's Ice Dam Park. He stated that twenty-five (25) years ago he painted the current entrance sign and has noticed it is now worn out. Mr. Trainer brought a design of the sign he would be doing along with antique ice tongs that he would like to include with the sign. He said he could have it completed in a month's time at the cost of \$500.00.

Township Resident Jill Refrew was present to ask the Board of Supervisors to have the section of Pohopoco Drive current speed limit of 50 mph be reduced to 40 mph. She feels where the speed limit needs to be reduced is at a bad spot along a curve and the sight distance is not good. Supervisors said they would have to look into the matter with our engineer because they would have to have a traffic study be completed. Supervisor Cressley stated we also will need Speed Limit Signs placed ½ mile apart and are needed in both directions

Township Resident Carl Haydt asked if the Township could contact PennDot regarding the "racetrack" from #209 and entering onto #248. He said Motorcycles do wheelies, trucks use their Jake brakes. He lives along State Road and hears all of the noise all day and night long. Chairman Kemmerer said he will let Chief Doll know about Mr. Haydt's concerns.

Township Resident Larry Williams was present to ask if the police have been visiting/patrolling the Phifer's Ice Dams this month due to the closure of fishing to sixteen (16) and above. He has not seen anyone patrolling. The Supervisors said they will speak to the Chief about this matter and also stated they are trying to crack down by working on installing cameras at the park


Public Comments/Questions
