

Franklin Township Advisory Recreation and Parks Board
May 2, 2023- Minutes

The Franklin Township Advisory Recreation and Parks Board met on the above date at the Franklin Township Administrative Building. Board members present were Fred Kemmerer Jr., Robert Correll, Travis Hunsicker, Officer Jared Green, and Brenda Cressley, Secretary. A list of others in attendance is attached. Chairman Kemmerer called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m. and led the meeting in saying the Pledge of Allegiance.

Fred Kemmerer Jr. made a motion to approve the minutes from the April 4, 2023 Franklin Township Advisory Recreation and Parks Board Meeting. Travis Hunsicker seconded the motion. Motion carried unanimously.

Fred Kemmerer Jr. made a motion to advertise the 2023 Franklin Township Advisory Recreation and Parks Boards monthly meeting dates to be held on the first Tuesday of the month at 6:00 p.m. Meeting dates will be advertised as follows:

Kim Hunsicker inspected the garage roof near the Main Road entrance of the park and estimated the garage will need approximately 8 square yards of shingles. He also noted the hole in the roof will need to be repaired as well and tree branches will need to be cut to be able to have the roof repaired.

A quote was received from Zeager Bros. Inc. for mulch needed at the Phifer's Ice Dam Playground Area. The quote was for 23 cy at \$25.30 per cy totaling to \$581.90 and \$781.50 was the delivery fee. No decision was made to purchase from Zeager Bros. Inc. Fred will search for another company to submit a quote.

The Board of Supervisors made a motion to change the movie night to Friday, May 19, 2023. The movie will be shown after nightfall.


